The purpose of this Demo is designed to quickly introduce ITELY Haircolor to a salon. You'll do a brief Introduction, product feature and benefit, then a model. This program should not be more than 1 - 1 ½ hours in the salon, unless the salon needs or wants more time. The salon is responsible for the model. An acceptable model is a slight color change, or simple grey coverage. No Corrective work, foils, decolorizing or tint backs.

The goal is to: show easy formulations, show great product performance, and to open dialogue with the stylist that leads to further conversations and opening a new door.

5 steps to Formulation

1. Determine the Natural Level – Clients natural level using the swatch chart
2. Determine the Desired Level – Does the client want to be darker, lighter or the same level
3. Determine the proper developer to use – Show the developer usage chart and how to utilize
4. Identify the natural color contribution at the desired level – Does the client want to be warm, cool or neutral? Then determine if you need to refine/neutralize or enhance/intensify this natural color contribution
5. Determine the percentage of gray – Show the gray percentage swatches and determine if the client is over 50% gray and formulate accordingly. If over 50% $\frac{1}{2}$ the formula must be an N, NI or TN series to compensate for the lack of pigment in gray hair.

Model formulation (salon provided)

Formulate model with stylist(s): ensure the model fills out a model release form

SHOW Equalizer Spray – Use Equalizer on the hair explaining the benefit of evening out porosity.

SHOW Derma Shield – Use Derma shield around the hairline explaining the benefit of using to prevent color staining on the skin during the application process.

Mixing and Application on Model – Show attendee how to mix the color by placing the color in the bowl, emulsifying it, then adding developer. Show how easy it is to mix our cream based color.

Have the Attendee(s) apply color to the model. Let them experience the ease of application, the pleasant fragrance etc., answering questions and making sure applications are applied well. Assist with application if needed. Process the model for the required time.

While model is processing:

SIMPLY BASIC COLOR EDUCATION - Level 1

This level of education offers a basic introduction into our 3 color lines. Classes can range between 2-4 hours and will include a model with basic formulation and application. Review the 7 stages of lightening

Hair bleaches are designed to decolorize hair. They contain ingredients that break down the melanin (pigment) in the hair. Hair must be pre-lightened to the proper stage to achieve true, desired results.

- Utilize Charts in the Power Point or Technical Guides

Developers

Review the developers that ITELY has and when to use them for your desired result.

- 10, 20, 30, 40 volumes
-

Toning

Toning is how we neutralize or enhance tones in the hair after we decolorize. Not all hair will need to be toned after it is decolorized.

- We tone level on level when a natural / warm results are desired
- When cooler results are desired, we lighten 1 level lighter than the desired level, then tone

Toning: Hair Damp vs Dry

- Best results are when the hair is at least 70% dry.
- When hair is towel dried (not dripping wet) it allows the toner to move easily through the hair and creates a sheer finish using less product, equalizes porosity and creates more even results.
- Toning on hair that is at least 70% dry, creates a more dense and accurate final result

Toning: Permanent vs Demi-Permanent

- Both are good options
- Demi Colors as Toners may be more reflective, and are ammonia free.
- Permanent Color may have a denser finish, because there is ammonia present, you may experience a little base break on hair that has not been lightened.

SIMPLY DEEPER COLOR EDUCATION - Level 2

Model formulation (salon provided) (or mannequin)

Formulate model with the stylist(s) and make sure to have the model fill out a model release form. Talk with attendees and decide on a simple technique and Decolorizer to use on the model. Something easy and not too time consuming.
